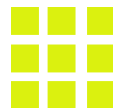

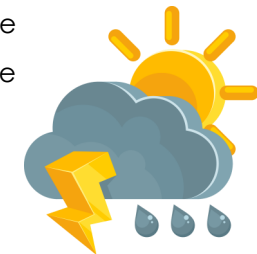

# Year 2 Knowledge Organiser - Spring Term 2 2026

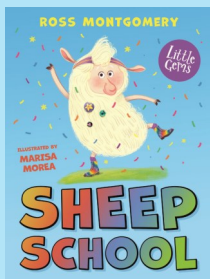
## Our English this half term!

## Geography

- This term we will be studying 'Weather and Climate.'
- We will be learning about weather patterns in and out of the UK and recording our own data about the daily weather changes that we see.
- We will be using rain gauges and weather vanes to measure rainfall and wind direction.

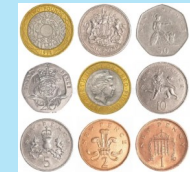


## Our Maths this half term!

This half term we will tackle time and money – two extremely important skills for life!

Children will be learning to identify o'clock, quarter past the hour, half past the hour and quarter to the hour. They will also learn to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes!

Following on from previous learning about money, we will be extending the children's knowledge of the value of coins and notes.



## PSHE

This half term in PSHE we are learning all about 'Keeping Safe.' We will be exploring how risky situations can be and making sure that we can all name 5 trusted adults to go to if we feel unsafe.

We will learn how to stay safe online, at home and in our local area. This includes health and safety when cooking and the importance of road safety.



## Music

This term in Music, children will embark on a musical adventure as they learn to play the glockenspiel! They will discover how to read simple music notes, play melodies and create their own rhythms. Through fun, hands-on activities, the children will explore the magical sounds of the glockenspiel and develop their confidence as young musicians.
