## **Isle Dance Competition – Monday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019**

As you know, Isle Dance is quickly approaching! We would like to take this opportunity to give a few important messages and reminders about the day.

### **Itinerary for Isle Dance on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019**

On Monday 11<sup>th</sup> February, we will be travelling to Medina theatre, by coach, at 1:15pm from school. Pupils will have normal lunch at school before they leave.

### **Rehearsals – Medina Theatre 1:30pm**

Children will spend the afternoon in the theatre rehearsing and watching other schools perform.

### **Dinner 5:00pm**

At 5:00pm all the children will be able to go through to the dining area to have their packed lunch and get ready.

### **Evening Show 7:00pm**

The evening show will start at 7:00pm and finish at approximately 8:45pm. Tickets are on sale for £5 from Medina Theatre Box Office. If you have purchased your child's tickets via the school you should have now received these. During the evening, a panel of judges will score each performance a mark out of 10 on the following criteria: choreography, performance skill, drama, concept, hair and make-up, costume, and soundtrack. At the end of the evening a prize ceremony will be held where the awards will be presented along with the announcement of the top-scoring school.

### **Collection 9:00pm at Medina Leisure Centre Entrance**

Children will need to be picked up from Medina Theatre at 9:00pm. For safety reasons, we will sign children out when they are collected. Children will not be permitted to leave with parents after the performance without being signed out by a teacher. Children will get changed out of costumes, in their dressing room backstage, then we will gather together outside by the leisure centre entrance for parents to meet us for collection. If parents have been inside the theatre to watch their child's performance, please don't try to find your child inside the theatre – meet us outside at the collection point.

### **School Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> February**

On Tuesday, children will be expected to arrive at school as normal for 8:45am.
