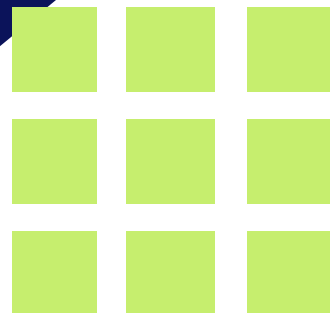

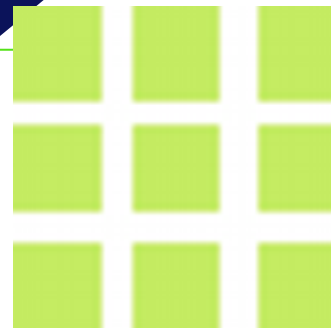

Each pupil can be accompanied by up to 2 guests on the evening as this will allow all pupils to have the opportunity to be supported by family members and friends.

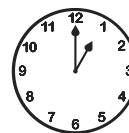
Pupils will need to arrive at school at 5.45pm in order for the event to begin promptly at 6.00pm.

All Autumn Term Enrichment Clubs begin on Monday 7th September 2026 and run through to Thursday 17th December 2026.



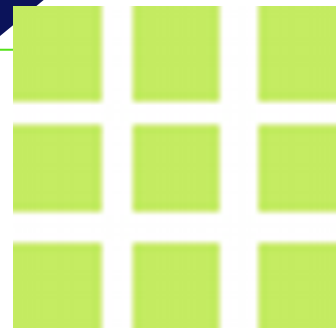
