In PSHRE we will continue to learn about healthy relationships with a particular focus on friendships. Children will be taught how to




recognise if someone isn't being a true, caring friend and how to spot signs of an unhealthy relationship.

We will complete the learning with a focus on extending children's knowledge about money.


Our English this half term!
