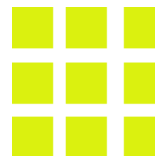
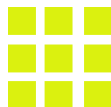

Year 1 - Autumn Term 1 2024 -

Science

This half term our topic is 'Animals'. We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and look at whether all humans have the same body parts.

We will also look at our five senses and how we use them in our everyday lives. During the term we will complete different experiments using our five senses to see whether there are any differences between humans.



History or Geography

This half term our topic in History is 'Toys'. We will investigate how toys have changed over time. We will be looking at similarities and differences between toys and how the materials and technology has changed over time.

The children will have the opportunity to look and explore old toys from Carisbrooke museum and compare them to modern, new toys that the children will bring into school.

Computing

This half term we are looking at Technology around us. The children are learning what technology actually is as well as looking at different technology in our lives.

The children will also be developing their mouse and keyboard skills as well as know each function of a computer - base unit, keyboard, computer screen, mouse etc.
