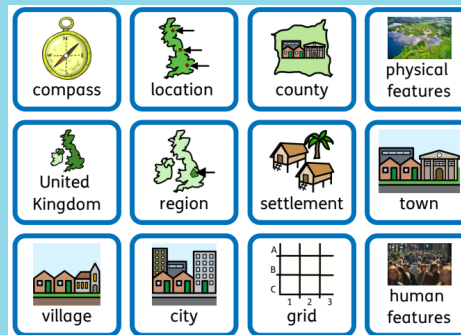

Geography

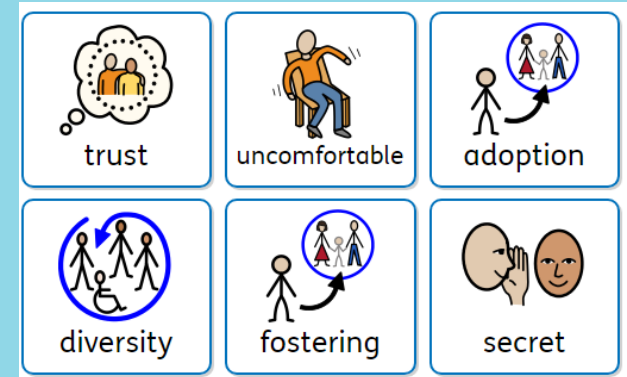

In PSHE this half term the children will be exploring feeling and emotions. They will explore secrets and dares as well as the dynamics of different families.

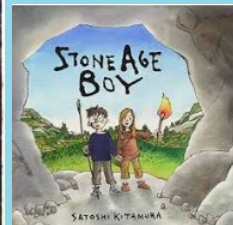
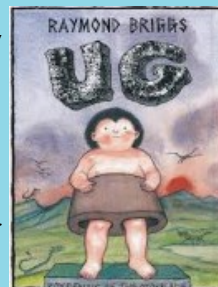


Our English this half term!
